The Public Hearing was opened by Supervisor Molé at 6 PM, followed by the Clerk reading the legal advertisement from the paper.

Supervisor Molé said that there have been no changes made since the Tentative Budget was presented to the Board.

Bookkeeper Hanley said that he has received the Budget for the Septic District. There is an error which he will look into before the November monthly meeting. He said that he has received the Fire District Budget which is \$90,129.00,

Molé said that there is a decrease in Town taxes but an increase in County taxes for 2014.

Councilman Rossley asked about the issue with the highway building being fixed and the C&D bin fix at the transfer station and no funds budgeted for either project. Supervisor Molé said that she has put in a grant for \$50,000 for needed repairs to the Town and there is a balance of \$76,000 in Good Neighbor money.

With no further comments from the Board or the community member, Supervisor Molé closed the Public Hearing at 6:16 PM
