Supervisor Molé opened the Public Hearing for the Local Law Creating a Local Roadway Work/Use Permit Program and Authorizing the Town Board to Receive Applications and Issue Permits at 6:00 PM. The Clerk read the Legal Notice.

Steve Burnett said that the ROW issue is a common one in Towns across America. This type of Law is standard operating procedure and he looks forward to this law being enacted to make Bovina like other Towns.

Chuck McIntosh asked how the Town will know if the structure is in the ROW. He said that's it's his opinion that the Town needs a way to prove something is in the ROW and where it's situated in the ROW. He asked how it will be determined where centerline of the roadway is. He said that Zoning has setback rules and would a property owner have to go to Zoning to get a variance. It's his opinion that this should be addressed. There are different setbacks in the Hamlet as there are in the General Rural District.

With no further comments, the Public Hearing was adjourned at 6:05 PM.
