

Here is a brief description of what the Board of Assessment Review does:

Our board consists of three (can have up to five) community members and functions to hear grievances on the assessed value of properties. The assessed value is a factor in determining how much you pay in taxes. Some grievances can be resolved by contacting our assessor, Kendra Cardillo. Others are heard by the filing of an official grievance form (RP 524) and submitting supporting proof prior to or at Grievance. Grievance is held on the fourth Tuesday in May; the board will review each grievance and come to a decision whether the assessment should be lowered. Currently our board has one vacant seat, leaving two members, one member is possibly retiring from the board. These are volunteer positions where the requirements are taking a video training course, via YouTube, once every 5 years and meeting on Grievance Day (4 hours at the Town Hall). This past Grievance Day we convened to review several grievances. *If we do not have a quorum the process would have to be handled by non-Bovina Officials from the County.*
